Swimming

To keep swimming costs to a minimum, we need to divide the total weekly amount between all our children. We ask for a donation towards the swimming costs, so even if your child does not swim on a particular date, we cannot offer a refund as the bus and the pool have to be paid for regardless of whether we swim. Please make sure that you send your payments half termly in advance. The cost for the first half of the autumn term is £18 or £42 for the full term (cheques payable to LCC-Diseworth School)

The cost for milk this term is £13.68 and is now due for payment (Cheques to 'LCC')

The cost of School Lunches has increased to £1.95 per day, and children may be pleased to know that Chips are back on the menu on Fridays

Children's Independence

We are really working hard on enabling the children to be more independent during school time. To help with this, please could you ensure that your children bring their own bags, lunchboxes etc into school in the mornings.
